IMPORTANT ITEMS TO CONSIDER BEFORE REGISTERING:

- Riders **MUST** be 8 years old before Camp begins. There is no upper age limit.
- The registration form outlines measurements that **MUST** be adhered to (inseam length and weight) both for safety and liability reasons.
- A parent, guardian or caregiver **MUST** stay at Camp, with each rider, each day, for the duration of the rider's session (75 minutes). Again, for safety and liability reasons.
- There is a **MANDATORY** parent (no children) and volunteer meeting on Sunday, June 4 at 4 pm. at Turnstone.
- More detailed information will be emailed to you once your registration form and payment have been received.
